

Instructions

All pilgrims are requested to carefully read and strictly follow the instructions given below for smooth, safe, and disciplined conduct of the tour:

1. Reporting & Departure

- All passengers must report at Madgaon Railway Station by 12:45 p.m. sharp on the day of departure.
- Train departure time is 2:00 p.m. sharp. Late reporting will not be entertained.
- Please report well in advance to avoid congestion and delays.

2. Food at Madgaon

- No food will be provided at Madgaon Railway Station.
- Passengers are advised to have their meals before arriving at the station.

3. Ticket, Registration & ID Card

- Carry a printed copy of your ticket (PDF received via SMS).
- Upon arrival at Madgaon Railway Station:
 - Complete registration
 - Collect your ID card and welcome kit
- Keep your ticket and ID card with you throughout the journey and show them to railway officials/examiners on demand.

4. Identity Proof

- Carry a valid photo ID proof at all times during the journey.

5. Luggage & Personal Essentials

- Carry your own blanket, personal medicines, and daily-use essentials.
- Ayodhya experiences very cold temperatures (up to 7°C):
 - Carry warm clothes such as sweaters, jackets, body warmers, shawls, caps, etc.
- Carry sufficient personal medicines for the entire journey.

6. Food Arrangement

- All meals during train journey (to and fro) are included & Free of cost.
- At Ayodhya breakfast & Dinner will be provided however afternoon lunch passengers will have on their own during temple darshan and sightseeing

7. Health & Medical Support

- An on-board doctor and medical team are available in the train ONLY for emergencies.
- Inform your tour coordinator in advance about:
 - Any medical condition
 - Allergies
 - Special medical requirements

8. Discipline & Group Conduct

- Strictly follow the tour schedule and timings announced by the coordinator.
- Always listen carefully to announcements and instructions given by:
 - Tour coordinator
 - Authorized staff
- Stay with your assigned group at all times. Do not wander alone.
- Do not change seats, berths, or accommodation rooms without prior permission.

9. Cleanliness & Behavior

- Maintain cleanliness, discipline, and mutual respect throughout the journey.
- Keep trains, coaches, buses, and accommodation premises clean.
- Respect all religious places, traditions, and local customs.
- Avoid unnecessary arguments or disputes with fellow pilgrims, staff, or local authorities.

10. Prohibited Items

- Strictly prohibited throughout the journey:
 - Alcohol
 - Tobacco
 - Smoking
 - Any intoxicating substances
- Violation of this rule will lead to strict action.

11. Safety & Valuables

- Passengers are personally responsible for their belongings such as:
 - Cash
 - Mobile phones
 - Medicines
 - Valuables
- Government of Goa shall not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings.

12. Changes & Authority

- The tour itinerary is fixed; however, changes may occur due to:
 - Weather conditions
 - Security reasons
 - Administrative instructions
- Any misconduct, indiscipline, or violation of instructions may result in removal from the tour.
- The decision of the tour coordinator and management shall be final and binding on all pilgrims.

13. Accommodation for fresh and change

Ayodhya is a small town, and as we are travelling in a large group of around 1,300 pilgrims, all passengers will be accommodated at one common location for better coordination and smooth movement.

- A large Ashram accommodation complex has been arranged at Ayodhya with halls, rooms, and tents for freshening up, changing, and short rest.

- Pilgrims are requested to use only the accommodation facilities arranged by the management and follow the instructions of the tour coordinator.

- Separate arrangements for male and female pilgrims are provided for freshening up, changing, and accommodation, in the interest of privacy and discipline.
